The EQA program "Urinalysis", consists of 4 surveys/year as follows:

- **Survey 1 and 3.** Each of these surveys shows two urine sediment particles. Each particle is presented both in bright field and in phase contrast microscopy and, when indicated (eg., crystals or lipids), also by polarized light.
  - Participants are asked to identify the particles shown. Moreover, for one particle (**SU-58** of survey 1 and **SU-64** of survey 4) they are also asked to indicate one clinical association, choosing it among 4 or 5 possible options.
- Survey 2 and 4. Each of these surveys presents a Clinical case. Clinical cases consist of a brief clinical history, which also include some key laboratory data and 4 phase contrasts microscopy images of particles found in the urine sediment of the case presented.
  - Participants are asked to identify the particles shown and to choose one possible clinical diagnosis, among 4 to 5 proposed.

The answers must be entered directly by the laboratory in our web site <u>www.centroricercabiomedica.net</u> within the expiring date of each survey, following the operative instructions reported in the web site.

Participants will be informed with an e-mail of the availability to consult the periodical and yearly reports.
